



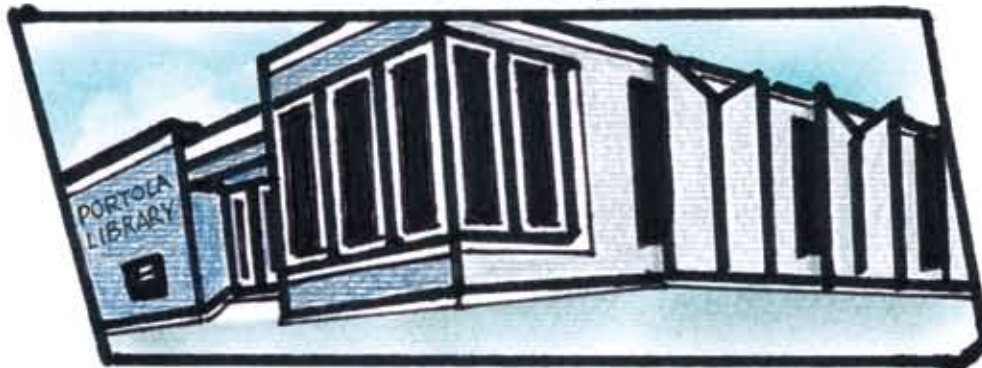
The Portola has changed since the 1980's. The demographic is changing as times change.
